**BRADLEY COUNTY DETECTIVES NAB SUSPECT
WANTED FOR ESPECIALLY AGGRAVATED ROBBERY**

CLEVELAND, TN. (MARCH 17, 2023) — On March 15, 2023, Detectives with the Bradley County Sheriff's Office apprehended Izak Sensibaugh, who was wanted for a recent Aggravated Robbery with a firearm.

The attention for Mr. Sensibaugh's whereabouts came after a March 5th call in Bradley County, where Izak Sensibaugh is alleged to have assaulted a man, then held a semi-automatic pistol to his head and taking the man's iPhone 14 Pro and Apple watch.

When Detectives located and arrested Mr. Sensibaugh, he was armed with a .380 semi-automatic handgun. Mr. Sensibaugh is being charged with Especially Aggravated Robbery, Unlawful Possession of a Weapon, Firearm Use in Association with a Felony, Theft over \$1,000, Simple Possession of Schedule 1 Narcotics as well as previous warrants for Failure to appear on two Aggravated Assaults and Vandalism. He is being held at the Bradley County Jail without bond.
