THREE ARRESTED FOR THE JUNE 28TH DRIVE-BY SHOOTING OF ROLLING BROOK HOME

CLEVELAND, TN. (SEPTEMBER 7, 2022) — On Tuesday, June 28, 2022, at 12:57 a.m., shots were fired from the street toward a home in the Rolling Brook Community. The home was occupied by two adults, two juveniles and one child. The shooting was believed to have occurred from a vehicle, targeting this home.

Detectives with Bradley County Sheriff's Office, in collaboration with Cleveland Police Department, were able to discover evidence that ties three adults to the shooting. The three being charged in the shooting were located via joint effort from the Bradley County Sheriff's Office Fugitive Recovery Team and Rhea County Sheriff's Office. Tayshawn D. Taylor 20, Eriq A. Caraballo 19 and Teja L. Wright 20 were charged and arrested, each with five counts of Aggravated Assault and five counts of Reckless Endangerment.
